POLICY STATEMENT

Post-professional coursework is restricted to doctors who have graduated from first professional degree programs. Full-time students currently enrolled in a first professional degree program may attend specific courses/seminars if they meet appropriate prerequisites and attain prior approval from the Dean of the Lincoln College of Post-Professional, Graduate and Continuing Education and the Dean of their respective college, however these hours shall not count toward eligibility for diplomate status. To register, doctors must give license numbers and students must show current student identification.
