POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of the University that qualified full time faculty members may be engaged to interpret radiographs that have been referred to the clinic system for interpretation by practicing physicians.

Because this is a teaching institution, radiologists are encouraged to include radiology residents in the process of reading referred radiographic studies, but in all instances, the report shall be signed by a qualified radiologist.

Radiologists who engage in this radiographic interpretation service shall do so under the aegis of a faculty contract and reimbursement may be received based upon the percentages determined by the University.

Because these radiographic studies are referred for interpretation to the University, the film reading may be done during regular salaried hours, as long as the faculty member is working under a faculty practice contract, which shall govern the details of the relationship between the faculty member and the University.

All radiographic studies referred to individuals (not to the University clinic system) who are employees of the University, must be interpreted outside of the normal hours of employment.
