Monographs

Books on massage might be found in all of our book collections but especially in the general circulating collection, in the reserve collection (textbooks recommended and/or required by instructor) and in our Special Collections area (classic titles; in-library use only).

In general, material on massage will be found in WB 537 (Massage) or WB 535 (Mechanotherapy. Massage, exercise, rest, etc., treated together).

Please remember that in addition to the above areas, some books also might be located in other subject areas related to a body region, an activity or a more general subject. Here are some examples:

- Information on **massage for sports injuries** might be located in **QT 260** with other titles on **Athletics** or **Sports**.
- Books on **shiatsu** might be found around within **WB 369** which is normally reserved for **Acupuncture**.
- Physical Medicine (WB 460) often contains some massage, while WB 541 (Exercise Therapy) might include some aspects of massage related to stretching.
- Books on **aromatherapy** might be located in **WB 925**, which generally is used for **Herbal Medicine**.
- Some books which include massage might be grouped in WB 890 (Special systems of therapeutics, including alternative medicine).
- Books on **reflexotherapy** will be found in **WB 962**.
- Books on massage for body regions or medical conditions might be located throughout various subject areas within the collections such as WE 100 (Musculoskeletal System. General Works), WE 344 (Arthritis), WE 500 (Muscles), WE 550 (Muscular Diseases), WE 755 (Low Back Pain. Sciatica), WE 800 (Extremities), WE 880 (Ankle. Foot, especially foot reflexology), WH 700 (Lymphatic System, especially massage for lymphatic drainage) and WM 172 (Anxiety, iucluding massage for stress).

You might wish to use the library's online catalog to locate other specialized subject areas.

One final note: books on **basic sciences** aspects are found in subject areas represented by the letter **Q** (e.g., **Physiology**, **Biochemistry** and **Pharmacology** in the listings above), while books on **clinical sciences** aspects are located in subject areas represented by the letter **W** (e.g., **Practice of Medicine** in the listings above).
