POLICY STATEMENT

It shall be the policy of National University of Health Sciences (NUHS) to provide service to the profession by participation of its faculty and, where applicable, their staffs, in various organizations that are intended to further the purposes of the associated health care profession. All participation shall be approved by the appropriate supervisor.

It shall be the policy of NUHS to provide service to the profession by making its facilities available to the health care professions and its members, such as use of the Learning Resource Center and/or the Training and Assessment Center. Nothing in this policy shall preclude the institution from requiring appropriate fees for utilization of its facilities and services.

It shall be the policy of NUHS to provide service in the following general forms:

1. Health care service to employees and students through the clinics of NUHS;
2. Health care to the public on a fee-for-service basis through the public clinics of NUHS;
3. Health care to the indigent through the Salvation Army Clinics.

NUHS, as evidenced by its current institutional goals, will provide service to the community by participation in various community events and also by offering facilities, personnel, and programs for community purposes, and also for the specific purpose of enhancing the health of the community where applicable, i.e., cholesterol screening, smoking cessation clinics, and the like.

It is the policy of NUHS to continue the activities of the Lecture and Cultural Affairs Committee for the purpose of bringing cultural events to the on-campus community as well as the community at large.

It is the policy of NUHS that the institution shall, through its agents, participate in various community organizations, such as the Federation of Illinois Independent Colleges and Universities, the Lombard Chamber of Commerce, and other similar agencies.
