## **POLICY STATEMENT**

It is the policy of National University of Health Sciences (NUHS) that those students who do not meet or fulfill all of the requirements, whether educational, financial or otherwise in order to graduate on the prescribed date, but who can be expected to complete said requirements in a relatively short period of time following the actual date of graduation, will sign a waiver which clearly delineates the fact that regardless of participation in the graduation ceremony and regardless of pronouncements made to the contrary, they shall not actually graduate until they have received their written diploma.

The specific instrument to be used for this purpose has been developed by NUHS legal counsel.

A copy of the waiver is available in the office of the Dean of Students.
