In addition, 30 elective credits in General Education, Liberal Arts, Life Sciences, or Physical Sciences are required for a total of 60 semester hours (90 quarter hours). Prerequisite courses must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
