English	6 semester hours	<i>ENGL 1101 English Composition I</i> <i>ENGL 1102 English Composition II</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIOL 2107K Principles of Biology I</i> <i>BIOL 2108K Principles of Biology II</i> Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHEM 1211K General Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 1212K General Chemistry II</i>
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHEM 2301K Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 2302K Organic Chemistry II</i>
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHYS 1111K Introductory Physics I</i> <i>PHYS 1112K Introductory Physics II</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSYC 1101 General Psychology</i> Other Psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
