English	6 semester hours	<i>ENGL 1101 English Composition I</i> <i>ENGL 1102 English Composition II</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIOL 1151 Principles of Biological Science</i> <i>BIOL 1152 Principles of Biological Science</i> <i>And corresponding labs</i> Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHEM 1551 Principles of Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 1552 Principles of Chemistry II</i> <i>And corresponding labs</i>
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHEM 2551 Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 2552 Organic Chemistry II</i> <i>And corresponding labs</i>
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHYS 1201 General Physics I</i> <i>PHYS 1202 General Physics II</i> <i>And corresponding labs</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSYCH 1100 General Psychology</i> Other Psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
