English	6 semester hours	<i>ENGL 101 Critical Reading &amp; Writing</i> <i>ENGL 102 Multimodal Composition</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIOL 161 Principles of Biology I</i> <i>BIOL 162 Principles of Biology II</i> Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHEM 161 General Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 162 General Chemistry II</i>
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHEM 241 Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 242 Organic Chemistry II</i>
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHYS 161 College Physics I</i> <i>PHYS 162 College Physics II</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSY 101 Introduction to Psychology</i> Other Psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
