English	6 semester hours	<i>ENG 115 First-Year Writing</i> <i>ENG 125 First-Year Seminar</i> Additional course needed in English, communications, literature, or a writing intensive course.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIO 151 Biological Investigations I</i> <i>BIO 152 Biological Investigations II</i> <i>and corresponding labs</i> Other biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHM 141 General Chemistry I: Bio-Organic Molecules</i> <i>CHM 142 General Chemistry II: Environmental</i> <i>and corresponding labs</i>
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHM 220 Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHM 221 Organic Chemistry II</i> <i>and corresponding labs</i>
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHY 141 Physics I</i> <i>PHY 142 Physics II</i> <i>and corresponding labs</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSY 100 Psychology: Science of Behavior</i> Additional course needed in psychology, including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, and perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
