Biology	2 courses	<i>BIO 101 & 101L Principles of Biology I & Lab</i> <i>BIO 102 & 102L Principles of Biology II & Lab</i> Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHEM 105 General Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 105L General Chemistry I Lab</i> <i>CHEM 106 General Chemistry II</i> <i>CHEM 106L General Chemistry II Lab</i>
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHEM 351 Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 351L Organic Chemistry Lab I</i> <i>CHEM 352 Organic Chemistry II</i> <i>CHEM 352L Organic Chemistry Lab II</i>
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHYS 105 & PHYS 105L General Physics I & Lab</i> <i>PHYS 106 & PHYS 106L General Physics II & Lab</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSY 101: General Psychology: Understanding Human Behavior</i> Other Psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
