English	6 semester hours	<i>ENG 101 Composition and Rhetoric I</i> <i>RES 104 Introduction to Research Writing</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIO 110 Human Biology and Lab</i> <i>BIO 111 Biological Science and Lab</i> Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHM 111 General Chemistry I and Lab</i> <i>CHM 112 General Chemistry II and Lab</i>
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHM 221 Organic Chemistry I and Lab</i> <i>CHM 222 Organic Chemistry II and Lab</i>
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHY 151 General Physics I with Lab</i> <i>PHY 152 General Physics II with Lab</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSY 110 Introduction to Psychology</i> Other Psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
