English	6 semester hours	<i>ENG 101 Freshman English I</i> <i>ENG 102 Freshman English 2</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIO 101 General Biology I</i> <i>BIO 102 General Biology 2</i> And corresponding labs Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHM 105 General Chemistry I</i> <i>CHM 106 General Chemistry 2</i> And corresponding labs
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHM 201 Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHM 202 Organic Chemistry 2</i> And corresponding labs
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHY 101 General Physics I</i> <i>PHY 102 General Physics 2</i> And corresponding labs Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSY 111 Introduction to Psychology</i> Other psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, and perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
