English	6 semester hours	<i>ENG 1000 English Composition I</i> <i>ENG 1100 English Composition II</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIO 1100 General Biology</i> And corresponding lab Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHM 1200 Chemistry I</i> <i>CHM 1250 Chemistry II</i> And corresponding labs
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHM 1000 General and Biological Chemistry</i> And corresponding lab
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHY 1200 Physics I</i> <i>PHY 1210 Physics I Lab</i> <i>PHYS 1250 Physics II</i> <i>PHYS 1260 Physics II Lab</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for one Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSY 1100 General Psychology</i> Other psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
