English	6 semester hours	<i>ENGL 100 Composition</i> <i>ENGL 110 Introduction to Literature</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIOL 106 Principles of Biology I</i> <i>BIOL 107 Principles of Biology 2</i> Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHEM 120 Principles of Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 121 Principles of Chemistry II</i> And corresponding labs.
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHEM 220 Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 221 Organic Chemistry 2</i> And corresponding labs.
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHYS 130 Physics I</i> <i>PHYS 131 Physics 2</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSYC100 Intro to Psychological Science</i> Other Psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
