English	6 semester hours	<i>ENG 110 Introduction to College Writing</i> <i>ENG 180 Public Speaking</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIO 235 Biology of Organisms</i> <i>BIO 238 Cell Biology</i> Other Biology courses including ecology genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHM 110 General Chemistry</i> <i>CHM 240 Inorganic Chemistry</i> <i>and corresponding labs</i>
Chemistry Organic/Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHM 220 Organic Chemistry I</i> <i>CHM 221 Organic Chemistry II</i> <i>and corresponding labs</i>
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHY 110 General Physics I</i> <i>PHY 111 General Physics II</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for one physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSY 110 General Psychology</i> Other Psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
