English	6 semester hours	<i>ENGL 101 Freshman English</i> <i>ENGL 150 Advanced Freshman English</i> Other English, communications, literature, or writing courses.
Biology	2 courses	<i>BIOL 110 Principles of Biology I</i> <i>BIOL 111 Principles of Biology II</i> <i>And corresponding labs</i> Other Biology courses including anatomy & physiology, botany, cell biology, genetics, microbiology, neurobiology, zoology.
Chemistry General or Inorganic	2 courses	<i>CHEM 105 Fundamental Chemistry I</i> <i>CHEM 106 Fundamental Chemistry II</i> <i>And corresponding labs</i>
Chemistry Organic or Biochemistry	2 courses	<i>CHEM 325 Organic Chemistry</i> <i>CHEM 326 Organic Chemistry</i> <i>And corresponding labs</i>
Physics	2 courses	<i>PHYS 203 College Physics I</i> <i>PHYS 204 College Physics II</i> <i>And corresponding labs</i> Statistics, exercise physiology, biomechanics, or kinesiology may be accepted for <i>one</i> Physics course.
Psychology	3 semester hours	<i>PSYC 110 Introduction to Psychology</i> Other Psychology courses including abnormal, child, community, developmental, experimental, educational, perceptual.
Social Science/Humanities	15 semester hours	Social Science/Humanities courses including those in economics, education, history, political science, psychology, anthropology, art/drama/music/film history or appreciation, languages, literature, english, logic, philosophy, and religion.

Science prerequisites are listed as guidelines only, and may vary. Students should contact the Office of Admissions to determine the exact science coursework required. All non-science credit hour requirements are as listed.

Each course must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Students must have earned a baccalaureate degree with a minimum GPA of 3.00 on a 4.0 scale. However, those students with a cumulative GPA between 2.75-2.99 may be considered for admissions under an Alternative Admissions Track (AATP). Please refer to the National University of Health Sciences Bulletin for additional admission requirements.
