



Electronic Access at NUHS: E-Journals, E-Books, Databases, and Streaming Videos

While you are at National, you have access to over 100,000 electronic journals, e-books, streaming videos and databases on campus and remotely.

Your electronic resources as a member of the NUHS community are listed under eResources in the right-hand menu on the library webpages on the school website.

If you are accessing these resources remotely you will be prompted for a login.



Unless otherwise indicated, this login should consist of your 14-digit library bar code and your 4-digit PIN.

Using the first listing under “Databases and Journals” on the eResources webpage, *A-to-Z (Full Text Finder)*, will provide you with the most complete listing and allow you to access these resources remotely while you are off campus.

A-to-Z (Full Text Finder)

- Provides a comprehensive online list of over 100,000 electronic journals, eBooks, and streaming videos. Search by keyword is preferable.
- A video tutorial on using *Full Text Finder (Publication Finder)* is available on the eResources webpage.

A-to-Z (Full Text Finder) can be used to browse for specific titles (recommended) or to search by subject (currently not as precise).

Remember that *A-to-Z (Full Text Finder)* is intended to provide you with access to publication titles. You cannot search directly for individual items that are contained within

the publication (such as journal articles or book chapters).

Searching *Full Text Finder (Publication Finder)* allows you to enter words or phrases in the search box.

You can Refine Results by available parameters (in the left-hand sidebar) such as Resource Type (journal, book, streaming video), Subject, Publisher, and even Limit To Peer-Reviewed Journals.

Some specific resources might require an additional login. In those cases, this information will be displayed in the Full Text Finder record for that resource when you are logged into *A-to-Z (Full Text Finder)*; that is, login information will be hidden from the outsiders’ view to protect our paid access.

Free and Open access content is available from resources such as FreeBooks4Doctors, Free Medical Journals, National Academies Press, and NCBI Bookshelf.

Subscription content available to you while you are affiliated with NUHS includes:

- Full-text articles provided through EBSCO databases;
- Full-text access provided by journal publishers, e.g. Elsevier (contact LRCJournals@nuhs.edu for a current list of Science Direct titles);
- Electronic books from the Springer eBook Medicine collections;
- Streaming videos

A-to-Z (Full Text Finder) has been configured to be as inclusive as possible. Access may vary depending on the provider.

Titles will be added and removed as our access changes. Please report any problems to LRCJournals@nuhs.edu

Other Tips

Please ask library personnel, especially the reference librarian, when you need assistance or instruction in accessing material.

When using a database, a link might be available from your search results. **The most effective route for proprietary content is through the LRC “eResources” webpage.** If working remotely, authentication (as pictured):



with your 14-digit barcode and pin ensures your accessibility.
