## **POLICY STATEMENT**

An 8<sup>th</sup> trimester DC, 9<sup>th</sup> trimester ND, 6<sup>th</sup> trimester MSc/Dac, or Mac-HM 8<sup>th</sup> trimester student who has not completed all courses specified in the first 8 DC/9 ND/6 Mac/Dac/8 Mac-HM trimesters, and who are deficient in one of the trimester 8 DC/9 ND/6 Mac/Dac/8 Mac-HM courses and who has received a grade of "F" or "U" in one course only (except for clinic, which must be passed), may choose to repeat the course during the following trimester clinic course, or may choose to take and pass an examination on the course by paying the course fee. The examination must be completed no later than two days prior to the end of the third week of the following trimester for which the students are otherwise eligible. These exams will be managed by the chair of the appropriate department.

### Procedures

The examination must be completed no later than two days prior to the end of the third week of the following trimester for which the students are otherwise eligible. These repeat exams will be managed by the chair of the appropriate department.
