Social Science	9 Semester Hours/ 13.5 Quarter Hours	Includes anthropology, economics, history, human geography, political science, psychology, and sociology.
Arts or Humanities	9 Semester Hours/ 13.5 Quarter Hours	Includes history, language, literature, philosophy, religious and cultural studies, performing and visual arts history or appreciation.

In addition, 30 elective credits in General Education, Liberal Arts, Life Sciences, or Physical Sciences are required for a total of 60 semester hours (90 quarter hours). Prerequisite courses must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
