English	6 Semester Hours	<i>ENGL 151 English Composition I</i> <i>ENGL 152 English Composition II</i>
Speech	3 Semester Hours	<i>SPCH 151 Communication Fundamentals</i>
Psychology	3 Semester Hours	<i>PSYCH 151 General Psychology</i>
Social Science	9 Semester Hours	Includes anthropology, economics, history, human geography, political science, psychology, and sociology.
Arts or Humanities	9 Semester Hours	Includes history, literature, philosophy, religious and cultural studies, performing and visual arts history or appreciation.

In addition, 30 elective credits in General Education, Liberal Arts, Life Sciences, or Physical Sciences are required for a total of 60 semester hours (90 quarter hours). Prerequisite courses must transfer at the baccalaureate level with a minimum 2.0 on a 4.0 scale. Cumulative GPA must be a minimum of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
