

Doctor of Naturopathic – Phase II Flexible Track Curriculum

The 9-trimester ND curriculum is based on completing each Phase (I and II) in 4 trimesters. The Phase II Flexible (“Flex”) Track option allows students to reduce the number of credit hours taken per term and complete course requirements at a pace that is consistent with their individual goals and learning styles. By following the Flex Track option, students may complete Phase II in 5 or 6 terms. The total credit load of 103.5 hours will be maintained regardless of the Flex Track option selected. In addition, all curricular requirements relating to course corequisites and prerequisites will be satisfied.

Choosing a Flex Track option should be weighed carefully. It is recommended that students seek the counsel of their academic advisor prior to making a final decision. Selecting the 5- or 6-term option will obligate students to remain in the designated track until the completion of Phase II.
