## LITERATURE REVIEW OF COMMON HEALTH CONDITIONS REPORTED CONCURRENTLY WITH SPINE CONCERNS: A SYSTEMATIC MAPPING REVIEW

Establishing a literature map of what is and is not known about spine concerns and associated health concerns can help set priorities for future epidemiological studies and systematic reviews that investigate complex questions. Future studies based on this knowledge can focus on the strength of associations, directionality of associations, and the potential influence of severity of pain, chronicity of a spine disorder, and the number of spine concerns an individual has on co-occurring conditions. Therefore, the purpose of this systematic mapping literature review is to chart the characteristics of the observational epidemiological literature that reports spine concerns and co-occurring disorders.
