CHIROPRACTIC EDUCATION AND TRAINING OF STUDENTS AND GRADUATES WORLDWIDE: A SCOPING REVIEW PROTOCOL

The purpose of this scoping review will be to identify and describe the available evidence on chiropractic education and training. Education and training of the health workforce is critical to reaching community and population health goals. Chiropractic educational programs aim to train chiropractors to practice in a safe and effective manner in a variety of healthcare environments.
