For remote access, you must have a current library card for the NUHS library (current students must update their card in our system each year).

Monographs

Books on **Homeopathy** (generally **WB 930**) might be found in all of our book collections but especially in the general circulating collection, in the reserve collection (textbooks recommended and/or required by instructor) and in our Special Collections area (classic titles; in-library use only). Another subject area of interest might be: **Hormesis** (**QT 104, QV 37**).

Books on **nutrition** are usually found in the following areas of the collections:

Please remember that although there are specific areas where most books on a subject will be located, some books will be located in other subject areas. Here are some examples:

- Information on **psychological aspects of homeopathy** might be located in **WM 100, WM 190** and **WM 400**.
- Additional information on **homeopathy** might be located in the **special systems of therapeutics** (**WB 890**); this is often used for complementary medicine as a broad category) will be found with other practice of medicine books.
- Books on basic science aspects of **Homeopathy** might be found under pharmacology handbooks (**QV 39**) and **materia medica** (**QV 760**).

You might wish to use the library's online catalog to locate other specialized subject areas.

One final note: books on **basic sciences** aspects are found in subject areas represented by the letter **Q** (e.g., **Physiology**, **Biochemistry** and **Pharmacology** in the listings above), while books on **clinical sciences** aspects are located in subject areas represented by the letter **W** (e.g., **Practice of Medicine** in the listings above).
