## Monographs

Books in this library are classified using the National Library of Medicine classification system. Books on **Chiropractic** (generally **WB 905**) might be found in all of our book collections but especially in the general circulating collection, in the reserve collection (textbooks recommended and/or required by instructor) and in our Special Collections area (classic titles; in-library use only). Other subject areas of interest might include: **Mechanotherapy (WB 535)** and **Osteopathy (WB 940)**.

Books on **Therapeutics (WB)** are usually found in the following areas of the collections:

**WB 113 (Integrative Medicine)**

**WB 460 (Physical Medicine. Physical Therapy)**

**WB 535 (Musculoskeletal Manipulations)**

**WB 541 (Exercise Therapy)**

Books on **Musculoskeletal System (WE)** are usually found in the following areas of the collections:

**WE 300 (Joints)**

**WE 500 (Muscles)**

**WE 510 (Trigger Points)**

**WE 708 (Neck)**

**WE 720 (Back)**

**WE 725 (Spine)**

**WE 735 (Curvatures)**

**WE 740 (Intervertebral Disks)**

**WE 750 (Lumbosacral Region)**

**WE 755 (Low Back Pain. Sciatica)**

Books on **Pain** are usually found in the following areas of the collections:

**WE 725 (Whiplash Injuries)**

**WL 342 (Headache)**

**WL 344 (Migraine and other vascular headaches)**

**WL 704 (Pain)**

Please remember that although there are specific areas where most books on a subject will be located, some books will be located in other subject areas. Here are some examples:

- Information on **sports medicine** might be located in **QT 260** and **QT 261**.
- Books on **mental healing (WB 880)** and on **special systems of therapeutics (WB 890)**; this is often used for complementary medicine as a broad category) will be found with other practice of medicine books.
- **Practice of Medicine (WB)** might contain some **chiropractic**, including **Encyclopedias (WB 13)**, **Outlines (WB 18)**, **Handbooks (WB 39)** and **Atlases (WB 17)**. Also consider specific aspects, such as palpatory **diagnosis (WB 275)** or **diet therapy (WB 400)**.
- Books on the history of chiropractic will be found with other **History of Medicine** books (specifically **general works in WZ 40**, **individual biographies in WZ 100** and **folklore** might be found in **WZ 309**).

You might wish to use the library's online catalog to locate other specialized subject areas.

One final note: books on **basic sciences** aspects are found in subject areas represented by the letter **Q** (e.g., **Physiology**, **Biochemistry** and **Pharmacology** in the listings above), while books on **clinical sciences** aspects are located in subject areas represented by the letter **W** (e.g., **Practice of Medicine** in the listings above).
